HEDIS Measure: Statin Use in Persons with Diabetes (SUPD) 2025



Measure

This HEDIS® measure assesses the percentage of members with diabetes who take the most effective cholesterol lowering drugs to lower their risk of developing heart disease.

HEDIS® is a registered trademark of the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA).

Numerator

Patients 40 to 75 years who were dispensed at least two diabetes medication fills on unique dates of service and were dispensed (prescribed and filled) a statin medication during the measurement period

Denominator (Eligible Patients)

Patients 40 to 75 years who were dispensed at least two diabetes medication fills on unique dates of service and were dispensed (prescribed and filled) a statin medication during the measurement period

Exclusions:

- Patients who use hospice services or elect to use a hospice benefit any time during the measurement year
- Patients with a diagnosis of Polycystic Ovary Syndrome (PCOS)
- Pregnancy or lactating
- Dispensed at least one fertility medication (for example, clomiphene)
- Patients with cirrhosis or end stage renal disease
- Patients with myopathy or rhabdomyolysis
- Pre-diabetes
- Patients in hospice or using hospice services anytime during the measurement year

Note: Exclusions require a submitted code each calendar year.

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Documentation Needed:

- Pharmacy claims for at least one statin fill/refill of any intensity during the measurement year
- Patients turning 76 during the measurement year must have statins filled in the month prior to their birth month for gap closure

Statin Medications

High Intensity Statins:

- Amlodipine-atorvastatin 40-80 mg
- Atorvastatin 40-80 mg
- Ezetimibe-simvastatin 80 mg
- Rosuvastatin 20-40 mg
- Simvastatin 80 mg

Moderate Intensity Statins:

- Atorvastatin 10-20 mg
- Amlodipine-atorvastatin 10-20 mg
- Ezetimibe-simvastatin 20-40 mg
- Fluvastatin 40-80 mg
- Lovastatin 40 mg
- Pitavastatin 1-4 mg
- Pravastatin 40-80 mg
- Rosuvastatin 5-10 mg
- Simvastatin 20-40 mg

Low Intensity Statins:

- Ezetimibe-simvastatin 10 mg
- Fluvastatin 20 mg
- Lovastatin 10-20 mg
- Pravastatin 10-20 mg
- Simvastatin 5-10 mg

Best Practices:

- Educate patients on the importance of taking the medication.
- Prescribe medications on the low or no-cost medication list.
- Write prescriptions for 90- or 100-day quantities.
- Encourage members to use mail order pharmacy benefits through CarelonRx, Inc.
